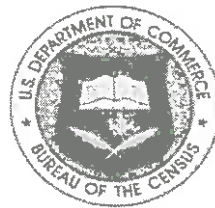
## New Export Regulations

As of July 2, 2008 in accordance with Title 15, Part 30, Foreign Trade Regulations (FTR), Shipper's Export Declarations (SED) must be filed electronically via the Automated Export System (AES). Prior to crossing the border, you must have an Internal Transaction Number (ITN) generated from the AES as proof of filing the required export information. You will have until September 30, 2008 to comply. In accordance with the FTR section 30.71(a)(1), any person or entity, including **U. S. Principal**

**Party in Interests (USPPIs), authorized agents, or transportation carriers (truck, rail, vessel, or air),** who knowingly fails to file or knowingly submits, directly or indirectly, to the United States Government false or misleading export information through the AES, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$10,000 or imprisonment for not more than five years, or both, for each violation.
